COMMUNITY HISTORY

Landis Lakes, the single family home subdivision, was developed by Steve Canfield. It is a 58 acre tract with 121 lots. Several builders worked in the development with custom built homes ranging from 3,200 square feet to 4,000 square feet and priced from \$400,000 to \$700,000. Sixty-nine lots were developed and sold to builders in the first phase. The second phase included 49 lots. Landis Lakes includes a clubhouse and swimming pool which are shared with residents of the Woods of Landis Lakes and Academy Ridge.

POOL NEWS

The pool opened on Saturday, May 24. Hours of operation are noon - 8PM, seven days a week. Pool will be open on weekends only after JCPS schools start on August 13. The last day will be Monday, Sept. 1, 2014 (Labor Day). Kids 12 and under must be accompanied by a parent or care giver 17 years or older. Guest passes can be purchased at the gate for \$5 a guest (exact change required) or a card of 10 visits for \$20 from Paragon (contact Paragon at 502-451-0485). New this year is the option to rent the pool before or after operating hours. Contact Paragon for more information.
